## *Class Tips*

### *Before Class*



- Before class pray for each student by name and each lesson concept specifically.
  - Review the goals of CompuVerse®.
- The lessons are meant to be a collection of applicable concepts.
- They are not usually in an all-or-nothing format.
  - Make sure there is appropriate lighting.
  - Try to provide chairs so the kids' feet reach the floor.
  - Keep any visual aids at eye level. If there are a variety of age levels, move the visuals around.
  - Collect and use appropriate materials from **Likeable Links** on our website **www.wsprog.com**.
  - Share that the PC Novice Magazine is an excellent resource for learning about computers in everyday English. Have a copy and show it if possible.
  - Select a verse to memorize.

### *During Class*

- Weave the gospel message throughout the lesson and not wait until the end. Satan will try to interrupt.
- Give consideration to lesson references of specific parental gender. Some children come from single parent families.
- Read the faces of the students. Some may be deeply troubled while another may just have poor reading/writing skills. Try to include each student in the lesson.
- Begin the lesson with a “grabber.” Use a story or puzzling question to hook their interest.
- Include a challenge with a gospel or missions opportunity.
- Review the previous lesson.
- Use a bit of a computer training video checked out from the local library.
- Get the mailing address of each student to be able to follow up.

### *After Class*

- With diligence try to become more personable with each student, his/her needs, and his/her environment.
- Within moments after the end of the class, make notes to yourself for improving the class the next time you teach it.
- If you've been blessed with helpers, get their ideas on how to make it better. Nurture them into doing more of the lesson. ☺
